2024 Per Capita

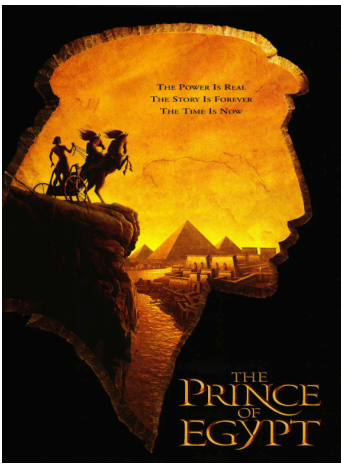
