For the past 23 years we have partnered with our mission partners in Erseke, Albania to bring Gods word and saving grace to the people of Albania. For the most part, we have assembled a mission team every other year to travel to this city on the southern part of Albania bordering Greece. Our focus has been to support the efforts of our partners Mark and Ruth Stoscher in building the church and a summer camp program for kids throughout the country. This has spread to adult programs and bible studies. Many of our trips helped build the infrastructure (buildings and outdoor facilities) to help attract young people. We have witnessed God at work in this country as more and more people give their lives to Christ.
