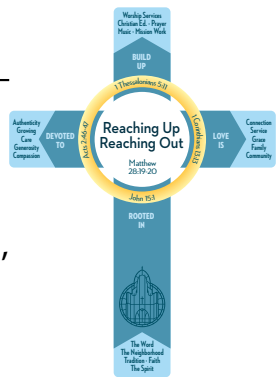
We are pleased to offer nursery care for children 0-3 years old at every service.

Mission Partner Focus – Colombia Mission

Dundee's partnership with the Prince of Peace Presbyterian Church in Bogotá, Colombia started in 2007– and have since gone on 7 mission trips to Colombia. The particular program within the church that Dundee works with is the PREA program, an after school program for elementary school-age children who live in high risk conditions. The program focuses on nutritional, academic, psychological, spiritual and recreational needs of the children – to assist in basics they are not able to receive at home. They are now expanding that program to youth ages 13-17. The primary location of the program is the church in Bogotá, with a second location in Alpes, 30 minutes outside of Bogotá where the children are even poorer. Dundee's Mission funds are used primarily for meals that the children receive, many times the only meal they have during the day. This need escalated during the pandemic, the children requested more food or would save some of their food for their families. The goal of Pastor Germán Suarez, the minister of the Bogotá church, is to teach these children about the love Jesus Christ has for them through the after school ministry the church offers through the PREA program. DPC will be going to Colombia next year, May 26 – June 3, 2023 to serve with this mission
