Ways to Get Spiritually Lost - Exodus 32

- Set limits on your relationship with God.
- Hone anxiety as your response to everything.
- Reshape God in terms of a nationalistic manifest destiny.
- Believe that everything is better when you're in control.
- Give into peer pressure.
- Interpret the Bible solely by "what it means to you."
- Put off having to make spiritual decisions.
- Scrutinize spiritual alternatives less than you scrutinize Christianity.
- Focus on God only when you're in church.
- Never address your anger with God head on.
- Don't pray.
- Trust culture to interpret who God is for you.
- Seek your personal comfort at all times.
- Fear looking weird because of your faith.
- Don't ground your beliefs in Scripture.
- Emphasize God's grace at the expense of his holiness.
- Emphasize God's holiness at the expense of his grace.
- Refuse to go deeper with God.
- Reject the idea that you need God's forgiveness.
- Believe only what you can see.
- Assume that all religions are basically the same.
- Fear doubt.
- Synthesize religious beliefs to fit your preferences.
- Avoid intimacy with God.
- Make and worship a golden calf while your pastor is off talking with God.

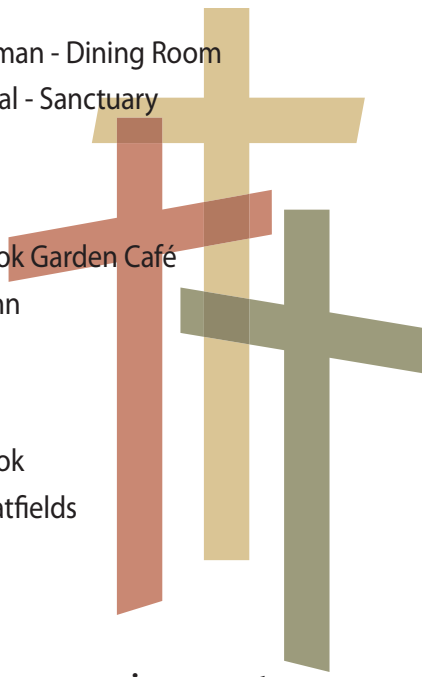
