52 Ideas on How to “Remember the Sabbath Day, to Keep It Holy”

(1) Spend the day with friends who tend to point you closer to God. (2) Spend the day with friends whom you might be able to point toward God. (3) Go for a long walk, during which you have a really good conversation with Jesus. (4) Take your family for a picnic. (5) Demonstrate mercy to someone in need. (6) Download some of your favorite worship songs and spend a couple of hours letting your heart sing to God. (7) Take a really long nap. (8) Participate in a worship service at a church in your community that has a different ethnic makeup than your regular congregation. (9) Read a Henri Nouwen book, like *The Way of the Heart*. (10) Choose to do the chores that someone else typically does in your house so that he or she might be able to rest. (11) Invite another church family to join you for lunch. (12) Take notes on the sermon and then review them before going to bed. (13) Sit by a river and watch the water go by. (14) Write your own psalm to God. (15) Make dinner on Saturday so that all you have to do is warm it up on Sunday. (16) Read one of the gospel books all the way through. (17) Spend the day thinking of all the things you can thank God for. (18) Have a progressive yard work day with three other families, ending with a barbeque at the last house. (19) Adopt a country and pray for Christ’s work in that country throughout the day. (20) Be the last one to leave your church, enjoying the conversations that the time affords. (21) Sit down in a Starbucks and see if God brings someone to you who might need a friend. (22) Call a friend with whom you haven’t spoken in a while. (23) Play catch with someone—anyone. (24) Memorize a Bible verse. (25) Do some yoga, using God’s grace as your focus point. (26) Read a Tolstoy novel. (27) Sit in your front yard, looking for opportunities to connect with a neighbor or two. (28) Play with your kids. (29) Visit an art museum and look for how the paintings and sculptures depict God. (30) Listen to the score from *Les Miserables*. (31) Prepare for a small group Bible study. (32) Do something to help the hungry, homeless, depressed, lonely, or infirmed who reside in your community. (33) Give thanks to God as you look through a family photo album. (34) Bake some cookies and hand them out to neighbors. (35) Skype with a missionary who is supported by your church. (36) Quiet your mind for at least ten minutes, picturing yourself sitting at a table with Jesus. (37) Read the texts of a couple of old hymns. (38) Spend together time with your spouse. (39) Leave a bag of groceries on someone’s doorstep. (40) Give a luxury away so someone else can enjoy it for a while. (41) Think of a meaningful and sincere compliment you can pay someone and then call that someone up and share it. (42) Skip lunch without drawing attention to yourself and let the hunger pangs you feel remind you to turn your attention toward God. (43) Write some cards of encouragement and appreciation to leaders in your church. (44) Choose a recipe and a friend and ask the friend to help you make the recipe. (45) Chew on a phrase from the Bible all day long, like “for God so loved the world,” or “the kingdom of heaven is near.” (46) Go for a run, choosing to think of the Father for the first third of the run, the Son for the second, and the Holy Spirit for the final third. (47) Pray through the Sunday paper. (48) Sit on a park bench. (49) Build a puzzle with someone whom you love or someone who needs a touch of love. (50) Tell someone the three things you enjoy most about knowing Jesus. (51) Surrender an un-surrendered part of your life to God. (52) Do whatever draws you closer to God and at the same time restores your soul.

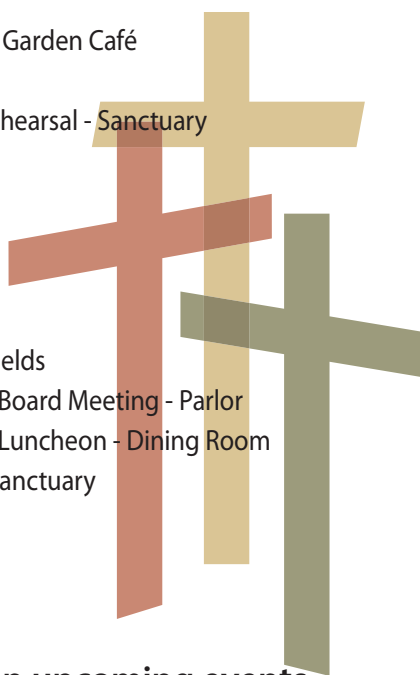
