1 Samuel 3:1-10

Romans 12:1-2

- As a group re-read the scripture
- What will you be doing in 12 hours?
 - Or rather... what do you have planned to be doing in 12 hours?
- JD talked about not knowing... we are supposed to follow without knowing... 12 hours from now... in our Capital Campaign... he mentioned Biblical Characters who didn't know the future and even in suffering, even in uncertainty, they followed... We are in good company... All of us don't know! Christianity is not waiting to know before we move!
 - How do you do with this?
 - How can we do better?
- Abel made an offering not based on logic, or economics. He did it without knowing his brother would be so jealous that Cain would kill him.
 - Do you think he would he have done it if he knew?
 - Would we do it? Even if we knew.
 - How do we help one another do it?
- Samuel gave a perfect response to the call of his name, just to the wrong guy!
 - How do you respond to God's call?
 - Who do we respond to?
 - God?
 - Ourselves?
 - Someone else that seems in charge?
- Paul tells us to offer our whole body, our whole self, as your perfect worship. JD said worship isn't just signing, or giving, or sitting in a pew. It's doing acting, leaping out in faith.
 - What do you consider worship?
 - How are you doing in your worship as Paul talks about it?
