Who is your favorite Bible Personality.

We make hero's out of Bible characters, think of them as great. But we forget God is great, and His grace and mercy is greater than His wrath.

- Do you see this as a problem?
- How do you do this in your own life?
- In what way can we break out if this pattern.

Roman's talks about the reckoning of righteousness. Knowing his unrighteousness Abram could do nothing but believe God and trust. This was counted as righteousness... not his works.

- How is your faith?
- Can you believe that you are not worse but the same as Abram and Noah and David?
- How can we help one another with this?

JD talked about natural theology and how we can see a Creator in the works around us. Showing us that it wasn't luck but with purpose that our world, our universe was made?

- What is your favorite part of nature that shows God is wonderful and real?
- How does that fall short in showing God's full power and glory?

God proves His love not in creation but in dying for you while you were still a sinner, still *ungodly*.

- How do you react to that? Like the guests at the dinner party?
- How should you respond? Like the woman who washed Jesus' feet with her tears and hair?

JD listed friends and congregants of his that confessed their sins to him. He told them that God has the ability to forgive them no matter who they are and what they've done.

- What would you have said?
- What would Jesus say to you if you confess your sins to Him?
