Psalm 133

1 John 1:1-10

- What do you think John meant in this passage?
 - How do you interpret:
6 If we say that we have fellowship with him while we are walking in darkness, we lie and do not do what is true; ⁷ but if we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
 - Why do you think this “makes our joy complete”?
- What actor and in what role do you always think of?
- As we consider Jesus reading Psalm 133 to us, how does this change the psalm for us?
 - What do you hear that is different than when you read it?
- Read John 3:1-21
 - How do you think Jesus spoke these words to Nicodemus?

 - Really?
- What are some ways the world (and Satan) tell you that you are without sin?
- In what ways is the world dividing us, not unifying us?
