- When have you worked really hard, did your research and studied to do something and you didn't succeed?
 - How did it feel?
- JD talked about the part of us that makes the safer, more logical picks, even when it comes to Jesus Christ. We go with the crowd, we ignore the call to faith, we hedge all of our bets and actions with the idea that “Jesus is great, sure, but there may be something better if I try something else besides Him.”
 - How often do you do that?
 - What happens usually?
 - Have others warned you against doing it?
 - How can we help others to go all in for Jesus?
- JD asked “What is the greatest desire of the human heart?”
 - What is your answer?
 - To be known?
 - To be totally free
 - To be completely secure?
 - To be home?
- In Revelation we learn that God's triumph will be complete! There will be no more pain, there will be no more tears, there will be no more death. A complete sense of well being, of belonging, and a sense of being home.
 - How do you see the end of time?
 - What's one thing that you are looking forward to?
 - What scares you about it?
