 - Friends
 - o Children
- Why?

- As a child what did you expect from your parents?
 - O What was unexpected?
- As a parent (if applicable) what did/do you expect from your children?
 - O What was/is unexpected?
- As we think about Moses' speech (you review it at Deut. 30: 15-20), why should the people obey the commandments?
 - o Is it because they must?
 - o Is it because they will earn their way to heaven?
 - o Is it in response to God's love?
- JD asked
 - "How well are you doing?"
 - "How well are you abiding?"
 - "How well are you obeying?"
- We need to stay grounded, and remain with God. Much like the relationship of a mother to her children that JD talked about. Even when our world grows and changes.
