 - Family
 - Discipleship
 - Relationship
 - Community

 - Joyful?
 - Painful?
 - Unsure?
 - Routine?

- What do you think it will be like when you arrive in heaven?
 - How will you respond to family?
 - How will you respond to God?

- How do we treat God?
 - Do we only accept what we can understand or explain away?

- JD talked about growing further from our faith as we try to explain God in ways we can understand.
 - How do you limit God?
 - How do you try to explain the things of God? (miracles, signs)
 - How far away are you from what JD described as “true faith”?

- How dedicated are you to being “unamazed”?
