 - o How do you see their faith working in their lives?
- JD talked about relying on the "impossibilities of God" saying nothing is beyond Him!
 - O Do you see that in your life?
 - Where and when?
 - o Do you depend on Him, really?
- Hebrews 11:1 defines faith, take a moment and re-read the definition.
 - O What is your definition of faith?
 - How is it similar and how is it different than the writer of Hebrews?
 - o We're called to believe God's way is better than our own. Do you truly believe that?
 - Do you fever doubt His plan?
- JD mentioned levels of faith:
 - Level 1: God exists.
 - Level 2: God loves us.
 - Level 3: God will provide for us.
 - Where are you on this scale?
 - Do you fail at level 3?
 - Tell of a time you saw God provide and you doubted He could do it?
 - How did that affect you?
- The Bible tells the story of a man who brought his demon possessed son to Jesus and when confronted with the question "do you believe?" He cried out "I do believe, help with my unbelief!"
 - O What is one of your struggles with doubt?
 - o How can ewe help each other through times of unbelief?
- Read through Heb 12 as a group.
 - O What do you see as similar among the people mentioned?
 - o What is different?
 - O Who do you identify with the most?
- Spend time in prayer this week asking Jesus to help you with your unbelief.
