Wednesday Nights are Dundee Church Night

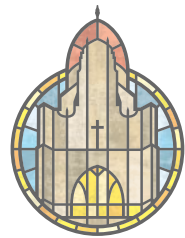
Dundee Church Night activities resume Jan. 10th.
