## 2024 Per Capita

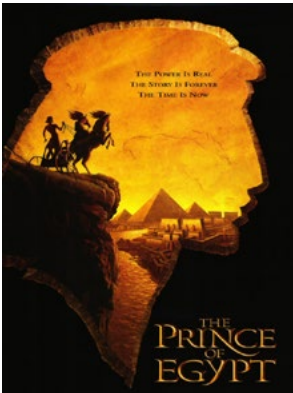

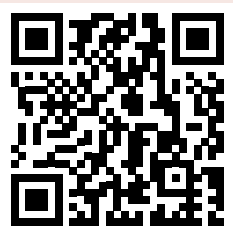

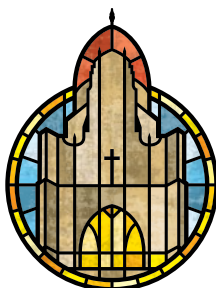
