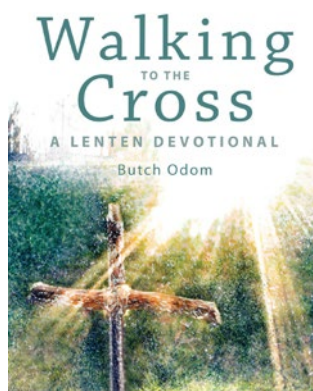


We are working with ABIDE and God is on the move!
