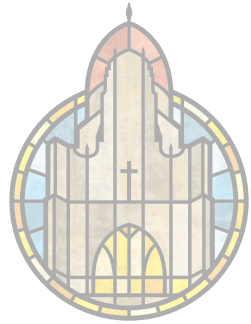
We're grateful for your presence today!

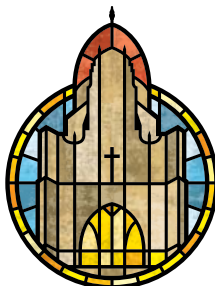
