This is a newly formed, Christian-based, higher education program for those in prison which focuses on changing the life trajectory of those incarcerated — improving the safety and security of our communities, and expanding the kingdom of God on earth.

Hope to the Hopeless looks to change the usual trajectory of almost 80% of prisoners who will return to prison by offering classes in Bible studies. We have the opportunity to help to transform the life trajectories of those in prison and improve their success in remaining free upon release! Education, the opportunity for higher education, can be that difference between a return to prison or a life of freedom in Christ.
