Mission Focus - Prince of Peace Presbyterian Church

Dundee's partnership with the Primera Iglesia Presbiteriana Church in Bogota, Colombia started in 2007 – since that time there have been eight mission trips to Colombia – most recently in May 2023.

Dundee works specifically with the PREA program, an after school program for elementary school age children living in high risk conditions. The program focuses on nutritional, academic, psychological, spiritual and recreational needs of the children, and is now expanding to youth ages 13-17. The program serves to assist the children/youth in some of the basics that they are not able to receive at home. They serve children in the primary location, the church in Bogota, and have expanded to Alpes, an area 30 minutes outside of Bogota – where the children are in even greater need. The ministry has grown to include a small school called Fusa and have a renovated farm in Ibague as a retreat center. Additionally, the farm retreat will serve as a financial resource so that the PREA mission can continue. Dundee assisted in the purchase of the retreat center.

Dundee's funds are primarily used for the meals that the children receive. Many times it is the only meal they have during the day. The goal of Pastor German Suarez, the minister of the Bogota church, is to teach these children about the love Jesus Christ has for them through action. Pastor German shows the children God's love through every aspect that is offered through the PREA program.

DPC Youth

This summer has been busy for DPC Youth - with two mission trips, weekly youth group, and VBS volunteering. The Dundee Church family is asked to continue to lift the Dundee youth in prayer. Pray that their experiences continue to enrich and embolden their faith and relationships.
