DPC Middle School Youth Mission Trip 2022



This year 12 middle school youth and 4 adults spent June 10-12 on a weekend of service in Omaha. We served at the Omaha Street School, the Open Door Mission, Abide Omaha, The Stephen Center, and The Hope Center. At each place we were called to serve in a variety of ways, cleaning out rooms, picking up trash, preparing and serving food, pulling weeds and holding up signs to advertise a pantry. We learned how we can all help each other and how the smallest things can make a difference in each other's lives. We talked to residents of shelters and students who succeeded because of the difference people made in their life. Each evening was spent in fellowship and discussion of how they saw God at work in their activity. A common theme was seeing how God works through many different people brought together for a cause and how God provides. The middle school youth served with joy and made an impression and impact on the community through our mission partners.
